Sterling Silver, comprising 92.5% silver, 7.5% copper, has thus been the standard for Jewelry since the 14th century in many parts of the world.

Silver is a popular material for jewelry because it can durable and can be finished in many different ways. It can have a shiny finish and almost made to sparkle.
